






Pond and Waterside Decking

Entrance Hall

A dramatic double-height space with a galleried landing and central log burner, the entrance hall is both a welcome and a statement. Natural light floods in from above, highlighting exposed beams and warm flooring. It sets the tone for the elegance and depth found throughout the home.

Kitchen

Vaulted ceilings, exposed beams and sunlight from triple-aspect windows make this kitchen both elegant and functional. A central island anchors the space for cooking and conversation, while bi-fold doors open to the terrace. With a Thornhill Range Cooker and wine cooler, it's designed for seasonal living and effortless hosting.





Sitting Room / Garden Room

Wrapped in glass and flooded with light, the sitting room invites calm connection with nature. Framed by gardens on three sides, it offers a peaceful escape in every season. Throw open the doors to summer air or curl up in winter with views of the ever-changing countryside.



Snug

Low beams, soft textures, and a log-burning stove define this deeply comforting space. Light plays through deep-set windows, warming the grain of timber and creating the perfect spot for restful afternoons or fireside evenings. It's a true hideaway, rich in charm and serenity.



Dining Room
